


The concerns are real for some of our Nevada workers most impacted by COVID-19. Nevada Housing Coalition partnered with the Guinn Center to get a snapshot of how the job losses impact workers in food service, retail, accommodations and gaming, relative to their housing costs. These workers are already considered severely burdened with over half of their incomes in normal times going to housing costs.

Note: **Food Prep and Serving Related Occupations** are cooks, bartenders, servers, dishwashers, etc. (chefs are excluded). **Retail Sales Occupations** are managers, cashiers, and retail salespersons. **Accommodations Occupations** are hotel, motel, and resort desk clerks. **Gaming Occupations** are managers, gaming dealers, gaming and sports book writers and runners, and gaming service workers (all other).
